The candidates are entitled for CII credits shown as above. In addition, IIRM offers 1 optional subject 'Personal Insurance' to train the candidates for appearing CII, London examination paving way for Dip Cii. However, Enrollment/examination formalities of CII have to be complied with by the candidate directly with CII,London.

2. Duration of the course: 6 months. Six months for 6 subjects & optional subject. (However, the candidates are allowed to complete the course in 3 years i.e., 6 consecutive examination chances.)

3. Eligibility for admission:

Pass at degree level , poly technique Diploma holders who studied 10+2+3 years (15 years of college study), Professional qualifications like C.A ., ICWAI & CS.

4. Procedure for applying:

Apply online (or) download application from www.iirmworld.org.in , send it to us enclosing copy of educational qualification certificate, photo and registration fee payment proof of Rs.500/- in respect of India based / NRI candidates, and USD 34/- in respect of Foreign candidates.

5. Course Fee:

For India based candidates	Rs 90,000/-
For NRI –special category	Rs 1,20,000/-
For Foreign candidates	USD 5,000/-



- 6. Course fee Payment :** Lump sum payment payable. The candidates may pay the registration fee / course fee, online using our payment gateway. Please visit IIRM website and click on "PAY FEE" option appearing on the menu bar of the home page.
- 7. Admissions:** Round the year. **TWICE YEARLY.**
- **January to June** : Cutoff date 31st December.
 - **July to December:** Cutoff date 30th June.
- 8. Contact classes/Examinations: Yearly twice**
- **May/June**
 - **October/November.**
- 9. Study material:** IIRM provides study material (books) and the same will be sent to the communication address of the candidate by courier.
- 10. Qualifying pass marks :**
- 55 % each subject.
- 11. Examinations chances/ RESIT :**
- 6 consecutive examination chances (3 years) with the proviso for re-sit in failed subjects upon payment of Rs1,000/- per subject by India based and NRI candidates & USD 200/- in respect of Foreign candidates.
- 12. Accreditations:**
- **IRDAI:** Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India has accorded recognition to IPGD Insurance courses of IIRM, on par with Fellowship of Insurance Institute of India (III), Mumbai, as suitable qualifications for Insurance services sector.
IIRM's IPGD- General Insurance Diploma will enable the awardees to appear for Surveyor/Loss assessor license examination with IRDAI. (IRDA notification No. IRDA/REG/18/76/2013 Dt.13/3/2013)
 - **CII-London** awards maximum of 140 credits. The successful IIRM diploma holders will be eligible for Dip Cii provided the candidates write one subject with CII, London at their diploma level.
 - **III, Mumbai** would award suitable credits paving way for award of ACII provided the candidates write certain compulsory subjects at their associate ship examination level.
 - **IRM, London** awards " *certificant of Institute of Risk Management (CIRM)*" to those who pass IIRM's diploma in Risk Management, without writing any examination. However the successful candidates have to apply to IRM, London duly paying registration fee to them for award of CIRM.
