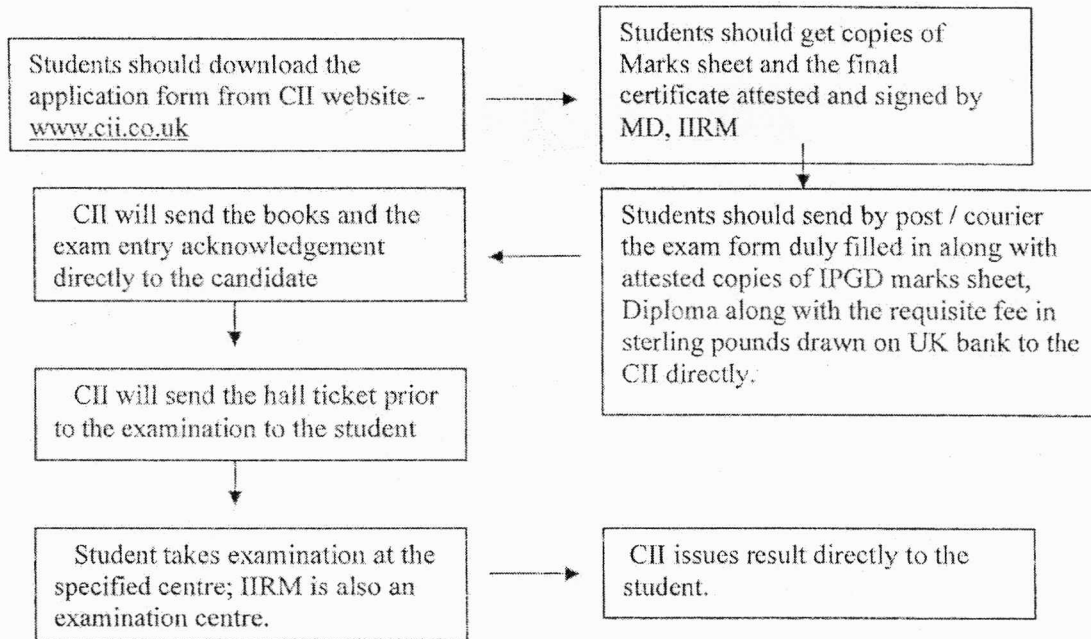


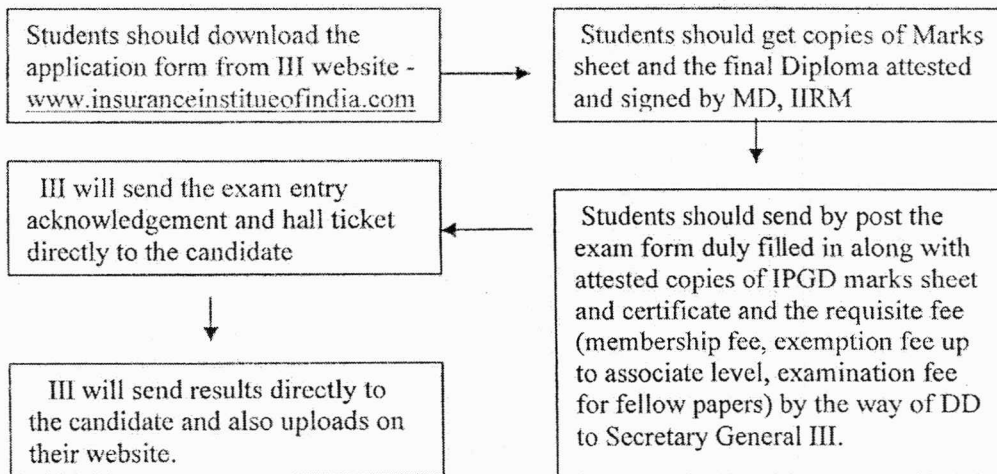
Instructions for writing CII Examinations (London)




Instructions for writing III Examinations (Mumbai)
